**Kunsthall Charlottenborg presents the Danish artist Henrik B. Andersen's show *Sliding Zones*. The exhibition consists of three large installations, which challenge the architecture of Kunsthall Charlottenborg.**

### **Henrik B. Andersen Sliding Zones**

Kunsthall Charlottenborg has invited Henrik B. Andersen to create a range of works that challenge and negotiate with the existing architecture of the building's north wing. The installations act as sculptural spaces within the spaces, with new walls and unexpected passages creating gradual transitions – or transitional zones – between new and old architecture.

The serial variations, rhythms and oscillations of the works produce tensions between the movements and the perceptions of the visitor. Infinite spaces alternating with intense spaces both relate to the proportions of the body and the scale of the architecture.

#### **BIO:**

Henrik B. Andersen is a sculptor, born in the town of Hornbæk in 1958. From 1999 to 2008 he served as a professor at The Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts, the Sculpture School Frederiksholms Kanal. Since 2008 Henrik B. Andersen has been a professor in the Department of Concept, Temporality and Space at the Vilnius Academy of Fine Arts in Lithuania.

#### **CATALOGUE:**

A catalogue presenting the finished work will be published in late June 2010. The catalogue includes text by Peter Borum, MA in French and PhD in literary history, and Ulrik Schmidt, a PhD student at the Department of English, Germanic and Romance Studies at the University of Copenhagen.
