## Research Programme

### Antechamber Salon

7 October – 31 December 2011

Vernissage: 6 October, 19-22.00

The autumn Research Programme at Charlottenborg is organised by the Belgian curator, writer and editor Dieter Roelstraete (b. 1972, based in Berlin). Roelstraete has created a display for the Antechamber and will be in residence in Copenhagen in November. During his stay Roelstraete will take part in a number of events, and will also work on a series of poems and corresponding critical commentaries that has occupied him for several years, and that will be published in 2012 under the title *Der Dichter Iwar von Lücken* ('The Poet Iwar von Lücken').

Iwar von Lücken was an early 20<sup>th</sup> century German poet who is now mainly remembered – if he is remembered at all – for having been portrayed by Otto Dix. Roelstraete's display at Charlottenborg maps the curator's explorations of the world of poetry, and one of the central elements is a life-size photographic representation of Dix's 1926 painting of the aforementioned *poète maudit* ('damned poet'). Roelstraete's programme has taken shape in close collaboration with his interlocutor in poetic matters, the American artist Jason Dodge.

Tonight sees the launch of Charlottenborg's publication for the Nina Beier exhibition. Dieter Roelstraete – who has written an essay for the book – speaks with Beier about the publication, which not only documents the exhibition but also acts as a project within it.

Wednesday 23.11.11, 19.00

Dieter Roelstraete's residency and display at Charlottenborg focusses on his passion for poetry. For this evening's discussion Roelstraete turns his attention to his poetic sources and inspirations, and talks to American artist Jason Dodge about the differences between dead European poets and living American ones.
